Board Member Qualifications

Each member of the Board shall meet the following qualifications:

1. A member shall be an elector of the district. An elector is an individual qualified to vote under section 2, Article II of the Oregon Constitution. The individual must be 18 years of age or older, registered to vote at least 20 calendar days immediately preceding any election in the manner provided by law and must have been a resident within the district for one year immediately preceding the election or appointment. Additionally, the individual must reside in the zone that he or she will represent;
2. A member shall have been nominated in accordance with Oregon law;
3. A member shall, before entering the duties of the office, take and subscribe the oaths prescribed by statute.
4. No person who is an employee of the ESD will be eligible to serve as a member of the Board while so employed;
5. In all proceedings for the nomination or election of candidates for or to the office of Board member, every petition for nomination, declaration of candidacy, certificate of nomination, ballot or other document used in connection with the nomination or election will state the position number to which the candidate aspires.
6. The term of each Board member shall commence on July 1 of the year in which he/she is elected and shall continue for four years.
