Vacancies on the Board

Vacancies will be filled by appointment by the Board. The Board appointee must be a legally registered voter and must have been a resident within the zone where the vacancy occurs for one year immediately preceding the appointment. The appointee will serve until June 30th of the next regular election, at which time a successor will be duly elected.

A Board member so elected as a replacement will:

- Serve the remaining years of the term of office of the Board member being replaced, or
- Will serve a full term of four years if the term is set to expire at the next regular election.

For example:

- If a Board member for zone 2 resigns after six months of service, the Board will appoint a person to fill the vacant position until the next regular election, which will occur two years after the election for zone 2. At the election, the newly elected successor will serve the remaining two years of that term of office.
- If a Board member for zone 2 resigns after three years of service, the Board will appoint a person to fill the vacant position until the next regular election, which will occur four years after the election for zone 2. At the election, because the full term of that office has expired, the newly elected Board member will be elected to serve a full four year term.

Upon appointment by the Board, the newly appointed Board member will be sworn and seated immediately.
