The following strategy for encouraging cooperation with your child is quoted from an article on the [Positive Discipline](#) website.

Ask for help: Telling children they are capable is not effective. They must have experiences where they feel capable.

1. Children feel capable, belonging, and significance when they contribute.
2. Look for every opportunity to say, "I need your help."
3. Be sure to let your children know how much you appreciate their help.
